# ERRIN – 2nd Training Seminar

- **Regions of Knowledge – ROK**
- A programme line in the FP-7-capacity-strand
- One call per year
- Approx. 10- 12 projects funded
- Rd. 1 Mio Euro per project
- Aims on: Capacity building for regions

# ERRIN – 2nd Training Seminar

- **Regions of Knowledge – ROK**
- Asks for triple helix-participation: academia-business-public service
- Lead- mandatory: Public service
- But: research driven cluster is key
- But: beneficiary can be one partner from triple-helix; not necessarily public service

# ERRIN – 2nd Training Seminar

- **Regions of Knowledge – ROK**
- **Main objective of the programme:**
- **Better link of research – driven – clusters to the regional economy**
- **Better exploitation of research-results/resreach-infrastructure for the regional economy**
- **Main scope: Development of knoweldge economy**

# ERRIN 2nd Training Seminar

- **Regions of Knowledge – ROK**
  - *Differences to other funding lines:*
  - Involves regional dimension into FP 7 ; beneficiaries are regional authorities, research centers and / or business
  - Thematic focus quite strict (varying from year to year)
  - Funds for studies and concepts for implementation / not the implementation/ not infrastructure
  - Asks for Joint Regional Action plans of all partners
  - Be clear on the first two pages of proposal; show the big picture – later be precise in the work-out (action plan, financial plan, business plan)
  - Demonstrate political support from Managing Authority
