Shaping the NEB Facility

27 May 2024 | 15:30-17:00 CET

As a consolidation of the open dialogue between the ERRIN NEB Task Force and the Joint Research Center, New European Bauhaus Unit, ERRIN members are invited to provide inputs and recommendations to support the shaping and coherent planning of the newly launched of the New European Bauhaus Facility.

This meeting is a step of a twofold, 6-month, consultation process, which aims to gather inputs, key recommendations and good practices to better shape the two components of the NEB Facility and ensuring that the NEB Facility is built as close as possible to the needs of Member States and stakeholders. Specifically, ERRIN members are seen as strategic stakeholders to provide relevant content and feedback to the R&I component of the Facility. This will happen in an interactive session, which will see the direct participation of the JRC NEB Unit, allowing ERRIN members to gain direct insights into the proposed structure and future developments of the Facility and to influence the content of its two components with their place-based knowledge and cross-sectorial experience.

A questionnaire will also be released, to further extend and enrich the inputs collected and allow targeted feedback. Inputs form the consultation process will feed the Roadmap for the NEB Facility (expected in Autumn 2024).
