

Title: EWRC session: Improving co-creation in public services

On 7th October during the [European Week of Regions and Cities](#) Oslo Region is organising a virtual participatory lab “Improving co-creation in public services”.

The [Horizon 2020 project CoVAL](#) has – among other topics – studied 10 cases in five European countries to gain insights into the conditions and potential for user-centered innovation in public services.
