ERRIN calls for further support for Regional Innovation Ecosystems in

Europe

Following our dialogue with the European Commission on the role of regional innovation ecosystems in the Horizon Europe proposal, ERRIN is now continuing to promote regional interests in the European Parliament. The draft reports of MEP Christian Ehler and Dan Nica already highlight the need to increase coherence between research and innovation priorities between European, national and regional levels. However, in our amendment proposals ERRIN suggests an even stronger role for regional innovation ecosystems. Read our amendment proposals.
