Too complex?

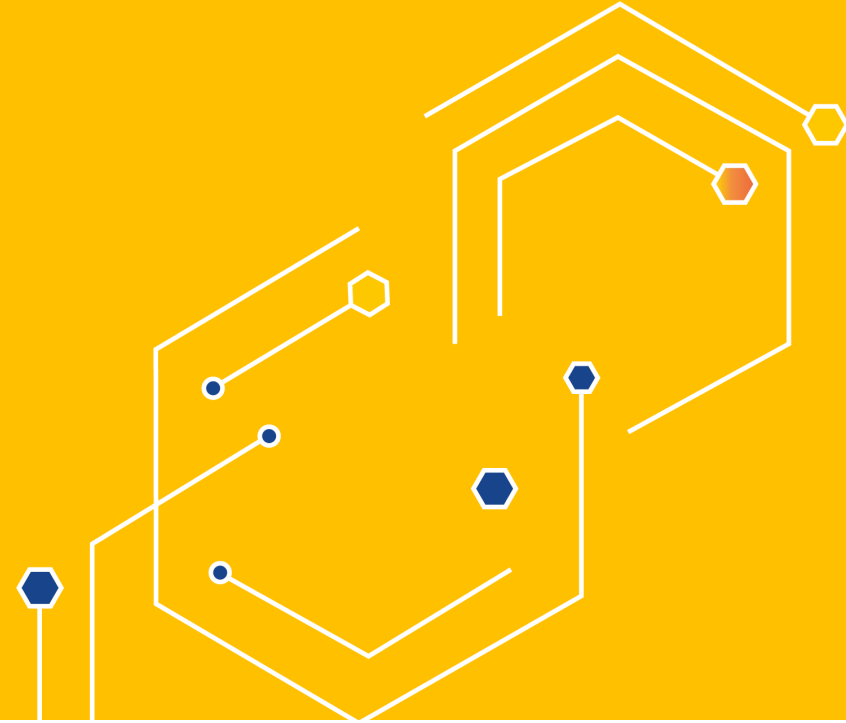
