On the 23 – 25 May 2023, the 24th edition of the European Conference on Energy Transition will be held in Bordeaux Métropole.

The 2023 edition, entitled "Acting together towards carbon neutrality in 2050", will focus on the importance collective action and "doing" together, with a programme of debates, roundtables, interviews, testimonials, workshops and site visits. Nearly 3,500 participants - local authorities, scientists and experts in ecological transition, economic players and associations - are expected to attend the Palais des Congrès in Bordeaux, to debate and share their experiences in the energy transition of territories and adaptation to climate change.

Within the framework of this event, a space dedicated to the European cities that are involved in the EU Mission "Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities" launched by the European Commission will also be offered in addition to the programme of the Conference.
