The landscape of European initiatives and funding available for regions and cities to strengthen their innovation ecosystems is very complex. Through its activities, ERRIN has raised many suggestions to include the ecosystem perspective and regional dimension in Horizon Europe in a more systematic way, while supporting members in navigating the different opportunities. Awareness, understanding and taking advantage of these EU initiatives may indeed bring great added value to the development of regional and local innovation ecosystems. At the same time, another path towards the same objective can be explored in parallel. Exchanging practices, challenges and solutions with regard to different regional innovation ecosystems' development journeys can offer a wide range of useful insights for building and improving the existing structures and their performance.

Finally, after a wrap-up, there will be a chance for further discussions and exchanging contacts during the networking coffee.
